Species	Count	Type	Comment
Beaded Chestnut (<i>Agrochola lychnidis</i>) *	4	Macro	Resident. The larvae feed on unspecified grasses and low growing plants.
Feathered Thorn (<i>Colotois pennaria</i>) *	3	Macro	
Green-brindled Crescent (<i>Allophyas oxyacanthae</i>) *	3	Macro	Resident. Larvae feed on hawthorn, sloe and garden apple.
Merveille du Jour (<i>Griposia aprilina</i>) *	1	Macro	Resident. Larvae feed on oak.
Red-line Quaker (<i>Leptologia lota</i>) *	1	Macro	Resident. The larvae feed on Sallow and willow (including grey willow).
White-point (<i>Mythimna albipuncta</i>) *	1	Macro	Immigrant and episodic resident. Larvae feed on unspecified grasses.
Yellow-line Quaker (<i>Leptologia macilenta</i>) *	4	Macro	Resident. The larvae feed on oak, beech and hawthorn.
