Red-line Quaker (Leptologia lota) *	1	Macro	Resident. The larvae feed on Sallow and willow (including grey willow).
White-point (Mythimna albipuncta) *	1	Macro	Immigrant and episodic resident. Larvae feed on unspecified grasses.
Yellow-line Quaker (Leptologia macilenta) *	4	Macro	Resident. The larvae feed on oak, beech and hawthorn.
